

McGregor Founder's Day Vendor Booth Rules

- Booth space: Single 10x10

You must provide your own tent or covering. Tents and coverings must be properly secured and constructed. You must also provide your own tables and/or displays. You are responsible for your own signs for advertisement and sponsorship. Please use good taste and judgement in your setup.

- Taxes and Licensing: Vendors are responsible for all applicable licenses, fees, and tax requirements. State taxes must be paid to the State Comptroller at a rate of 8.25%. See the Comptroller's website for more information. <https://comptroller.texas.gov/taxes/sales/>
- Cleanliness: Vendors are responsible for keeping the area neat and clean. All trash and debris should be disposed of throughout the day and after booth breakdown. Trash receptacles will be located throughout the festival grounds.
- Description of items: You are required to give a description of items sold on your application. This helps us with advertising. All items sold are subject to approval by The McGregor Movement.

Prohibited Items:

- Vendors may sell pre-packaged baked goods or jarred/canned food. **No other type of food or drinks may be distributed at the vendor booths.**
- Marshmallow/potato guns • Silly string • Stink bombs • Any item displaying vulgarity • Colored sprays

Hours of Operation

Festival Hours: Saturday, 9am through midnight

Setup Times: Saturday morning beginning at 6:00am until 8:00am

Unloading: Vehicles may be parked as close to your booth space as possible beginning 6:00am on Saturday for setup. **All vehicles MUST be removed from the festival area by 8am - NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Breakdown: Begins Saturday at 4:00pm and must be completed no later than 12pm.
